Job Summary

Provide regulatory oversight as per the requirements of the Jamaican Civil Aviation Regulations 2004 (JCAR), with emphasis on the areas covered by ICAO Annexes 1, 6 and 8 This includes the monitoring and surveillance of all operations in the areas of aircraft maintenance, air operator certification, maintenance organization certification, aircraft servicing, ramp operations and maintenance engineer licensing, for air operators and maintenance organizations in Jamaica and for all Jamaican air operations overseas.

Minimum Requirements/Knowledge/Skills

Reporting to the Manager, Airworthiness, the incumbent is expected to meet these minimum requirements:

- Hold an Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Licence, either
 - (a) type-rated or approved on at least two types of aircraft; or
 - (b) endorsed for Avionics systems
- Ten (10) years work experience in an aircraft maintenance facility, in an airline or the military, as an aircraft maintenance technician, or any combination of these roles, with experience in the maintenance and repair of airframes, power plants, and systems of large aircraft (over 5700 kg gross take-off weight) under a continuous airworthiness inspection and maintenance program; or in the provision of maintenance services for smaller aircraft up to the level of annual checks. (For Avionics specialists, the emphasis will have been on the electrical, electronic, communication, navigation, instrument, auto-flight systems, and related systems)
- Three (3) years supervisory or managerial experience in aircraft maintenance. This includes such positions as lead mechanic, quality assurance inspector, or duty engineer.
- Have no history of enforcement or disciplinary action.
- Working knowledge of the Civil Aviation Regulations in the areas of AME licensing, airworthiness requirements and aircraft registration.
- Investigative and analytical skills
- Problem solving and decision-making skills
- Planning and organizing skills
- Good interpersonal and communication skill
- Computer literate and able to utilize the Microsoft Office Suite effectively
