Cargo Suspension Lifted for Canada and the Bahamas

The Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority, JCAA is advising that the temporary suspension placed on cargo operations from Jamaica to Canada and the Bahamas has been lifted.

The lifting of the suspension on cargo operations from Jamaica to the Bahamas and Canada means that cargo and duty free items will now be allowed to leave the island for these countries.

However, the temporary suspension of cargo from Jamaica to the United States remains in effect until further notice.

The JCAA will continue to provide additional information on the matter as soon as this becomes available
