## JCAA Probes Aircraft Occurrence

The Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority, JCAA has commenced its investigation into an aircraft occurrence at the Norman Manley International Airport in Kingston this morning.

Early reports indicate that a Cessna 152 aircraft registered 6Y-JGA with a pilot and one passenger on board overshot the runway. Both persons were taken to hospital where they are being treated.

It should be noted that normal operations continue at the Norman Manley International Airport.

Efforts are now being made to remove the aircraft which blocked a section of the Port Royal Road.
