NORMALITY RESTORED TO AIR TRAFFIC SERVICES

The Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority (JCAA) wishes to advise that normal operations have been restored to the air traffic services. This means that activities at the island's airports and aerodromes should not experience any undue delays as a result of limitations with the service

Normal operations were restored at 11:00 p.m. on Monday, May 23, 2011. This after the island's air traffic controllers who had previously withdrawn their services reported to work.
