### JAMAICA'S SAFE TO HOST ICAN

May 25, 2010

**For Immediate Release**

The Government of Jamaica has imposed a Limited State of Emergency to a small section of the island. The State of Emergency is only in effect for Kingston and St. Andrew where the Security Forces are conducting an operation to serve an Arrest Warrant on Michael Christopher Coke.

Since this activity is confined only to a small section of the island, the island's two airports remain open. Jamaica's tourist towns of Negril, Montego Bay, Ocho Rios and Port Antonio are no way impacted by the activities in Kingston and remain safe."

Events such as the ICAN 2010 Conference scheduled for Montego Bay will take place as planned. It should be noted that Montego Bay is on the island's popular *North Coast* and is approximately four hours away from Kingston by car.
