JCAA ADVISES OF 12-HOUR BREAK IN SERVICE PROVISION UNTIL 7:00 A.M. MONDAY

The Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority is advising that, as it progresses with efforts to achieve a full restoration of Air Traffic Services at the Kingston Air Traffic Control Centre, it has become necessary to suspend the provision of services from 7:00 p.m., Sunday, September 10, 2017 to 7:00 a.m., Monday, September 11, 2017.

Since 11:00 p.m., Saturday, September 9, 2017, limited Air Traffic Services have been provided to facilitate incoming, outbound and over-flights within Jamaica's Flight Information Region.

The JCAA thanks all stakeholders for their continued patience and support, as work continues to restore normality in the shortest possible time.
