Incoming, outbound and over-flights will begin to operate within Jamaica's airspace, as the JCAA gets closer to achieving full restoration of Air Traffic Services.

Technicians from Aeronautical Telecommunications (AERTOTEL) Ltd. and the JCAA's Communications, Navigation and Surveillance personnel continue to conduct restorative work to enable the full functionality of the radar and communications systems in the shortest possible time.
