Aircraft Movement – NMIA & SIA

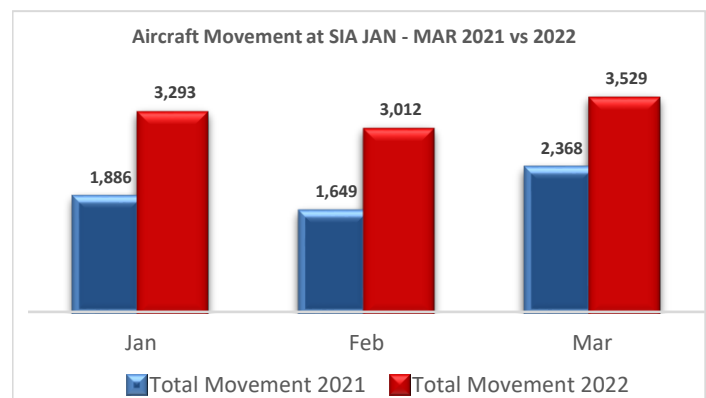
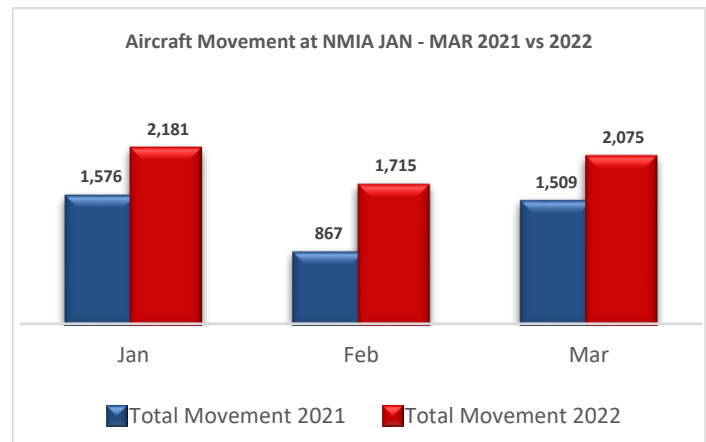
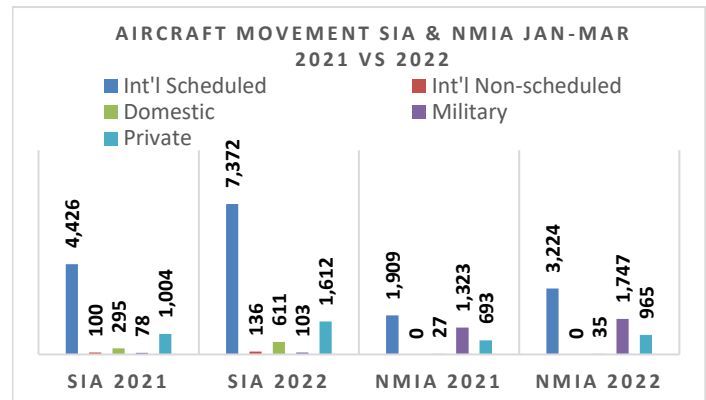
Total aircraft movements at the Norman Manley International Airport (NMIA) and Sangster’s International Airport (SIA) for the period January to March 2022 were **15,805**, an increase of **60%** when compared to the **9,855** aircraft movement recorded in the same quarter in 2021.

Norman Manley International Airport (NMIA)

Aircraft movements at NMIA for the first quarter 2022 totaled **5,971**, an increase of **51%** when compared to same period in 2021 where movements were **3,952**. Of the total aircraft for the 2022 period, **3,224** were international scheduled aircraft, **35** domestic aircraft, **1,747** military aircraft and **965** private aircraft. For the 2021 period of the **3,952** aircraft, **1,909** were international scheduled aircraft, **27** domestic aircraft, **1,323** military aircraft and **693** private aircraft.

Sangster’s International Airport (SIA)

At the SIA, total aircraft movements in the first quarter of 2022 were **9,834** compared to **5,903** aircraft in the same period in 2021, an increase of **67%**. Of the aircraft for the 2022 reporting period **7,372** were international scheduled, **136** international non-scheduled, **611** domestic aircraft, **103** military aircraft and **1,612** private aircraft. For the 2021 period of the aircraft **5,903** were international scheduled aircraft, **4,426** international non-scheduled, **100** international non-scheduled aircraft, 295 domestic aircraft, **78** military aircraft and **1,004** private aircraft.



Aircraft Movement at KTP, NEG, IFIA & POT

Overall aircraft movements for the period January to March 2022 at the domestic aerodromes and IFIA were **3,524** an increase of **96%** from the **1,798** aircraft recorded for the same period in 2021.

TINSON PEN (KTP)

Aircraft movement at Tinson Pen for the reporting period increased by **90%** to **1,800** aircraft; with **equal** arrivals and departures, conversely for same period in 2021, **948** aircraft were recorded; **469** arrivals and **479** departures.

NEGRIL (NEG)

Negril Aerodrome also reported an increase in aircraft movement for the January to March 2022 period. Movements increased by **115%** to **1,392** aircraft from **646** aircraft reported for the 2021 period. Arrivals and departure for the 2022 period was **808** and **584** respectively, the 2021 period recorded **323** arrivals and **323** departures.

IAN FLEMING INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (IFIA)

Aircraft movement at IFIA for the reporting increased by **55%** to **199** with **105** landings and **94** takeoffs. Movements for the 2021 period were **128** aircraft with **65** landings and **63** takeoffs.

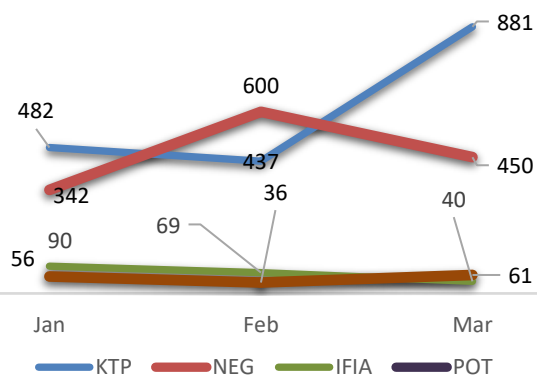
KEN JONES (POT)

Ken Jones Aerodrome noted **133** aircraft movement from January to March 2022. This was a **75%** increase in aircraft movement from **76** aircraft arrivals and departure for the period in 2021. In the 2022 reporting period there were **67** arrivals and **66** departures. The 2021 reporting period recorded **39** arrivals and **37** departures.

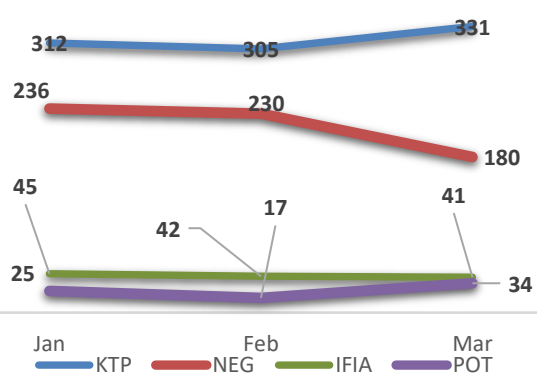

Aircraft Movements at Domestic Aerodromes Jan - Mar 2022

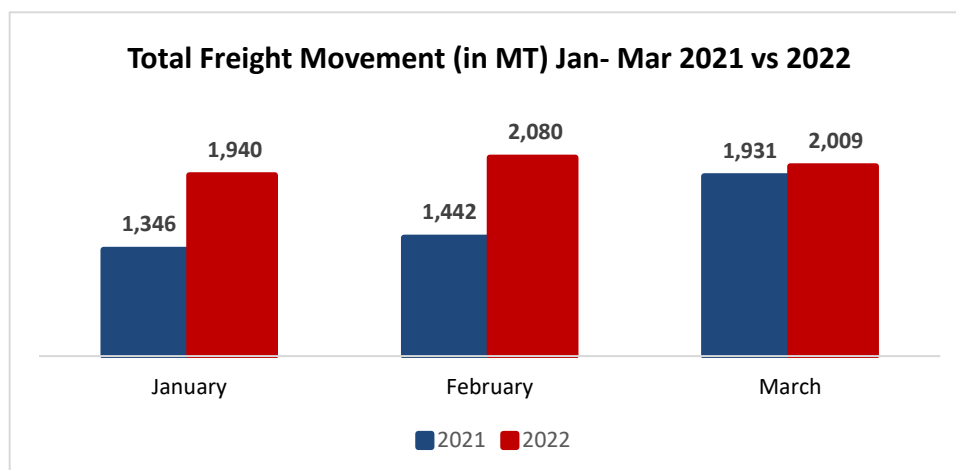


Aircraft Movements at Domestic Aerodromes Jan - Mar 2021



CARGO ACTIVITY AT NMIA & SIA

Cargo movements at the international airports NMIA and SIA for the period January to March 2022 were **6,029 metric tonnes (MT)**, which represents a **28%** increase from freight movement of **4,719 MT** in the same period of 2021. Freight movement for the reporting period at NMIA was **4,603MT**; **1,243MT** loaded freight and **3,360MT** unloaded freights. On the other hand, SIA contributed **1,426MT** of freight, **1,168MT** loaded and **258MT** of unloaded freight.

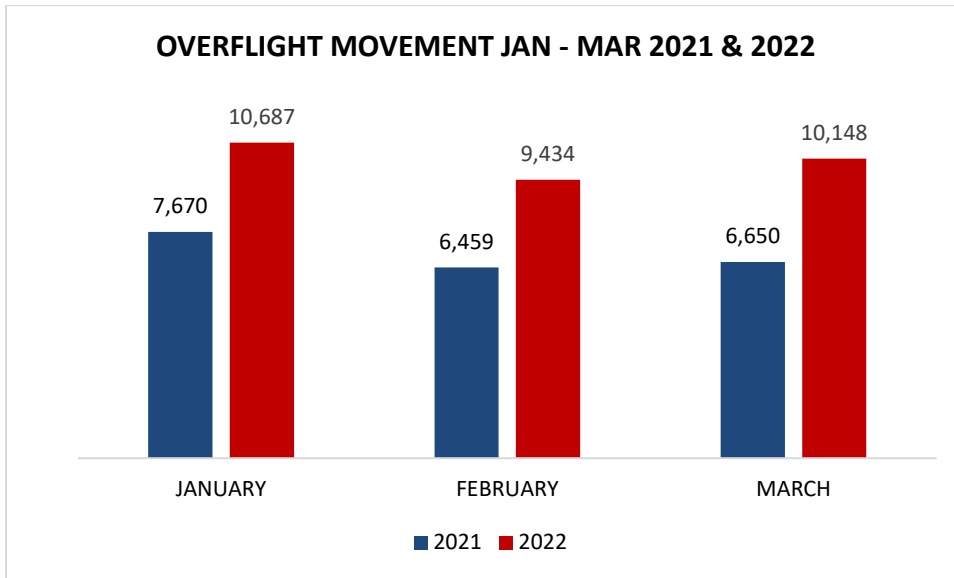

Overflight Aircraft Movements

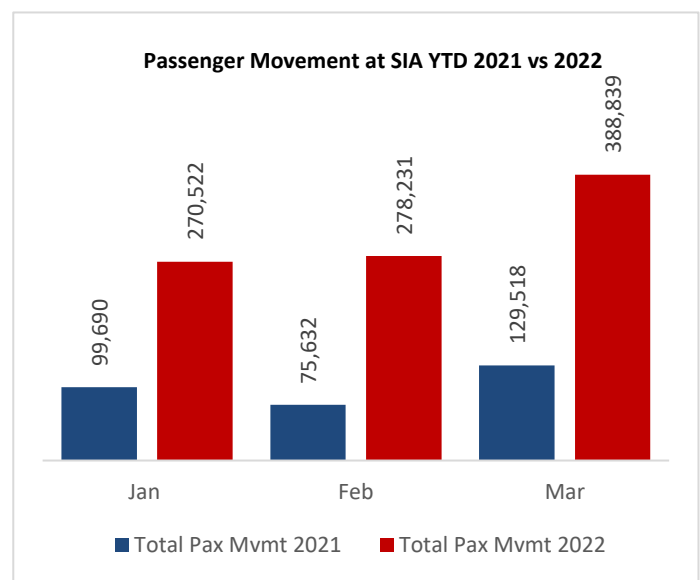
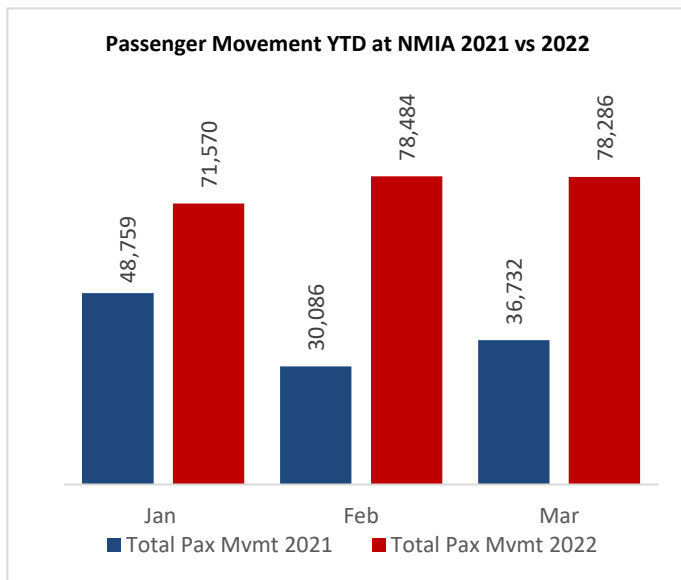
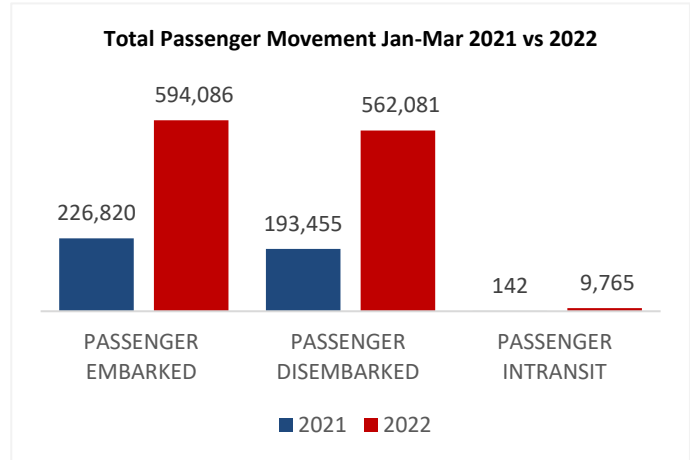
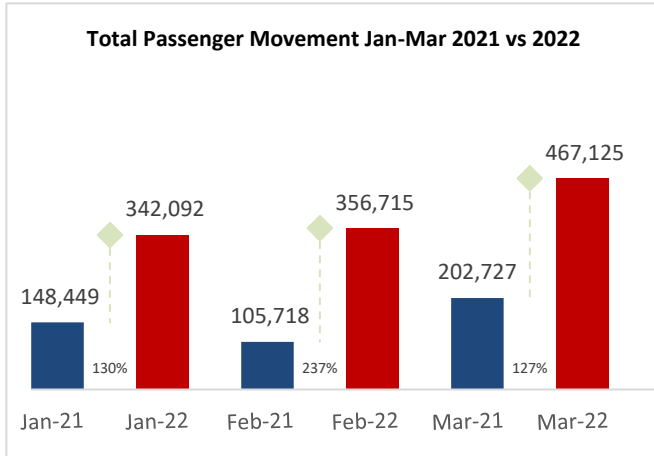
In the first quarter of 2022, January to March, Jamaica FIR recorded a total overflight aircraft movement of **30,269**, this represents an increase of **46%** from the **20,779** overflight aircraft movements in Q1 2021. The average number of daily overflights for the period January to March 2021 and 2022 were **230** and **336** respectively.

Passenger Movements at NMIA & SIA

Total passenger (includes international and domestic passengers) movements at NMIA and SIA for the first quarter 2022 was **1,165,932** increased by **155%** from the figure reported for the same period in 2021, which was **456,894** departures, arrivals and transit passengers.

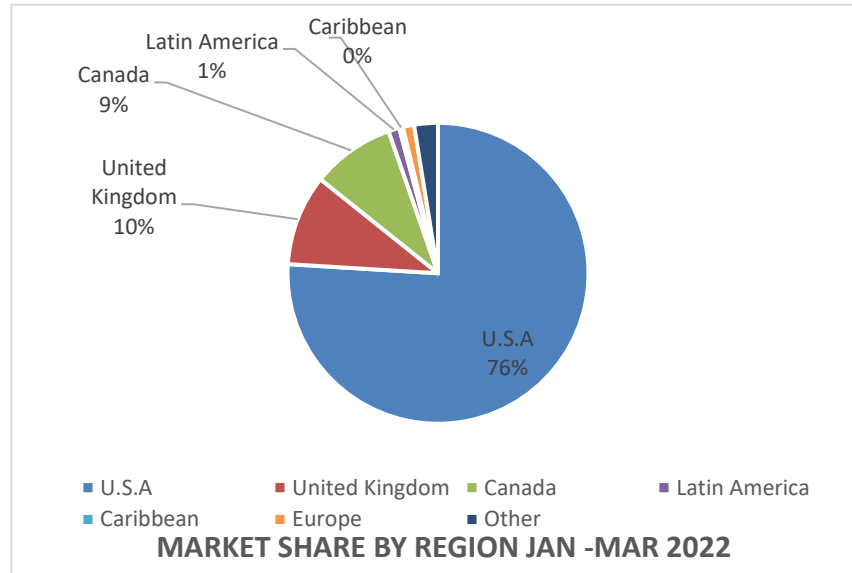

Passenger Arrival by Region

Total passenger arrivals for the reporting period were **562,081**. This was a significant increase of **191%** from the figure of **193,455** arrivals reported for the same period in 2021.

Passenger Arrival by Airlines and Load Factor

The table below depicts the distribution of passenger arrivals by airline carriers for the period January to March 2022 period. Topping the list with the most passenger arrivals by carrier we find American Airlines with approximately **131,000** passengers, followed by JetBlue Airlines with approximately **83,000** passengers, thirdly we have Delta Airline with approximately **81,000** passengers.

Load Factor is calculated by dividing the total number of passengers carried by an aircraft by the total number of seats available on that aircraft, **expressed as a percentage**. The year-to-date load factor is approximately **67%**.

Permits, Flight Authorization and Licenses Issued
